Uprkos razvoju političkog i regulatornog okvira za obnovljivu energiju i energetske efikasnost, ulaganja u ove sektore su i dalje niska. Pokretanje dekarbonizacije i energetske tranzicije zemlje zahtijeva snažniji angažman lokalnih vlasti, lokalnih nezavisnih proizvođača električne energije i lokalne zajednice. Saradnja između navedenih zainteresovanih strana na osmišljavanju, razvoju, implementaciji i upravljanju projekata održive energije leži u srži privlačenja investicija u održivu energiju. Nove mogućnosti za sufinansiranje inovativnih projekata energetske zajednice ili drugih partnerstava predvođenih zajednicama biće predstavljene u okviru projekta EU 4 Collective Action for Energy Transition (EU4CAET). Nakon prezentacije slijedi panel diskusija s predstavnicima lokalne zajednice koja se bavi trenutnim neizvjesnostima u procesu uspostavljanja energetske zajednice, izazovnim pitanjima, očekivanjima i mogućim rješenjima za razvoj niza inovativnih projekata energijskih zajednica i podršku njihovoj uspješnoj implementaciji. Sve ovo ima za cilj osigurati da se ekonomske, ekološke i društvene koristi dekarbonizacije osjete lokalno, pomažući u stvaranju otpornije i održivije budućnosti.

Despite the development of political and regulatory frameworks for renewable energy and energy efficiency, investments in these sectors remain low. Driving decarbonization and the country's energy transition requires stronger engagement from local authorities, independent local electricity producers, and the local community. Collaboration between these stakeholders in designing, developing, implementing, and managing sustainable energy projects is at the core of attracting investments in renewable energy. New opportunities for co-financing innovative energy community projects or other community-led partnerships will be presented within the EU 4 Collective Action for Energy Transition (EU4CAET) project. Following the presentation, a panel discussion with representatives of the local community will address the current uncertainties in establishing energy communities, key challenges, expectations, and potential solutions for the development of a range of innovative energy community projects and support for their successful implementation. The goal is to ensure that the economic, environmental, and social benefits of decarbonization are felt at the local level, contributing to the creation of a more resilient and sustainable future.
